 Prayer is the electric circuit to guide all of our decisions.

This is just my latest short list of hints from the Almighty. I would like to ask you the question that Howard Thurman poses: "What makes you come alive?" Let's begin with this . . . and pray about it. And if and when this begins to become clear, would you let me know? We listen together. My door is always open. God bless.

May long summer days Speak to you of God's enduring light.


